



## EDUCATOR OF THE YEAR AWARD

The Educator of the Year Award is presented to an ACFE Educator member who has made an outstanding contribution to anti-fraud education. Factors that will be considered in selecting the recipient are.

### **Criteria:**

1. The nominee/nominee organisation must have made a noteworthy contribution which significantly enhanced the educational standing of the forensic investigation/auditing profession in South Africa;
2. The individual must have made a contribution to the ACFE SA;
3. The individual might have been involved in Anti-fraud curriculum development efforts creating a career path for the profession at their university or college;
4. The individual might have involved other departments/faculties within the academic profession promoting the profession in doing so;
5. This individual might have been solely or jointly responsible for the number of CFE's that successfully came into the profession; and
6. As an organisation, the entity provided a unique opportunity for training of members and/or the broader public
7. The nominee should also be active in their community.

### **Eligibility:**

1. For individual nominees, preference will be given to nominees who have attained or are studying towards the CFE status.
